

M.E.S. and the Red Zone-What does this mean?

- School staff must always wear a procedural (or surgical) mask in indoor and outdoor common areas of the school.
- Only one stable class group is permitted at all times, with no physical distancing required, student can remove their masks in class (we already do this)
- Students from different class groups must stay 2 meters apart when moving around in common areas (we already do this)
- Field trips and interscholastic activities are suspended
- Students eat lunch with their stable class group (we already do)
- Continued sanitization
- Students 10 and over MUST wear a face covering on school transportation and in all common areas where social distancing is impossible. Face coverings must be washed.
- These three days will now be ped days:
 - ❖ January 25, 2021
 - ❖ February 15, 2021
 - ❖ March 26, 2021
- Due to the exceptional times we are living, and the added stress brought on by the pandemic, it was also decided to place two moveable pedagogical days (currently snow days) before the Christmas holidays. The following two days will also be ped days:
 - ❖ November 23, 2020 (moved from January 25, 2021)
 - ❖ December 7, 2020 (moved from March 26, 2021)
- We will continue to do our part and keep the school and its population clean and safe, but we ask that parents, guardians and caregivers help as well. Please talk to your children about the importance of handwashing as much as possible. Please explain to them the importance of social distancing. Rest assured that Mansonville Elementary School has a contingency plan in place in the event of another shut down.
