Dear families,

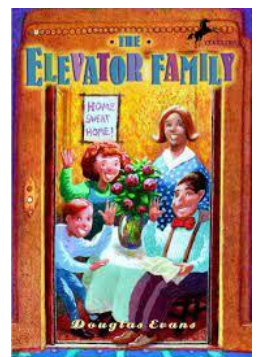
